
# SIGN LANGUAGE FOR THE CLASSROOM




- **1.** Right hand makes fist by right side of head.
- 2. Point index finger upward while turning hand.





- 1. Extend both hands out at chest level with palms facing down.
- 2. Move hands downwards twice.

## **Understand**




- 1. Extend right hand out at chest level.
- Face palm forward and move from left to right twice.

# Slow down



- Right fist held up from bent elbow at chest level.
- 2. Tilt fist down twice.

#### No




- 1. Bring right hand to chin.
- 2. Extend right hand out at chest level with palm open and facing up.

#### Yes



- Right hand index and middle finger extended, the remaining fingers are clenched.
- **2.** Tilt hand to the right twice.

# Thank you



- **1.** Hold both fists on either side of face.
- 2. Turn fists and point index fingers over your shoulders.

# Again



- 1. Right hand raised to right hand side of head. Palm facing forward with fingers loosely bent.
- **2.** Close hand to form a fist.
